



mini tennis – wet/bad weather policy

The safety of all our members is our top priority. We will not run a session if weather conditions make the courts unsafe. To give parents of our Mini Tennis members clarification of what will happen in the event of wet/bad weather, the following policy will apply :-

- The Coach running each session will make a decision as to whether the session will be run. Older children may play in conditions which would not be appropriate for younger children.
- If after the first 20 minutes of the session, weather conditions prevent the session from running, it will be cancelled and an alternative date will be set.
- It is the parent's responsibility to find out if a session is being run either by going to the Club or making contact with the Coach.
- Parents will be expected to collect their children if a session is cancelled due to bad weather. Any child who remains on the Club's premises without parental supervision after the first half hour of the cancelled session will not be offered an alternative date.
- One week will be added to the end of each course so any session cancelled due to bad/wet weather can be re-arranged.
